LOGLINE

Michael Wolffsen [Mane] has just gotten custody of his only sister's son after her husband murdered her before Michael's very eyes. When he receives an urgent phone call, Michael takes his nephew and wife and makes the journey home to his only other living relative: his estranged, eccentric (and extremely paranoid) father [Watson] who is obsessed with building an unassailable compound. Once there, Michael hopes to repair his shattered family, but instead he finds that they are all trapped inside his father's creation when the ghost of his vengeful brother-in-law [Mears] returns to wipe out the rest of the family.



INTRODUCTION

At the insistence of Michael Wolffsen's fiancée, Juliette, he is going home after years of estrangement from his father, Gary. Gary's new wife has called to let him know that his father is ailing and he should come home. Michael, Juliette, and his troubled nephew, Brandon, are on the way to the family estate far out in the middle of nowhere when they encounter car trouble and Brandon has a frightening encounter in the woods along the road.



Once they arrive at Gary's modest home, surrounded by acres and acres of grounds full of cameras and other security sensors, Michael is surprised and concerned to learn that his father is in the early stages of dementia. The house is now also covered in supernatural and occult symbols and wards. His new wife, Annabelle, has had enough and she informs Michael that she is leaving and Michael needs to resume care of his father.



Over the course of the first 24 hours, through a string of odd occurrences, some of them almost unexplainable, Michael begins to believe that Gary is a danger to both himself and others. Michael begins to make plans to take him to the nearest town to place him in a facility equipped to deal with his progressive dementia. Annabelle prepares to leave.





That is when the spirit of William, Chloe's husband and murderer, makes himself known outside the house, however, and the killing begins. Gary, Michael, Brandon and Juliette find themselves trapped in the very compound Gary was trying to build to ward off evil. And they're not alone. The spirit of Chloe has been there all along attempting to communicate, but no one has understood her message.



Gary, through his arcane fumbling has cursed them all in this life and the next, and now they must find a way to escape the house, defeat a spirit bent on revenge, and break the curse that will trap their spirits in the house forever.



The star and producer of COMPOUND FRACTURE is Tyler Mane, who recently starred in Rob Zombie's HALLOWEEN and HALLOWEEN 2 for Dimension, playing the infamous villain Michael Myers. The first film has grossed almost \$80 million world-wide since its August 2007 release and was released on DVD December 18, 2007. In addition, Tyler is also well-known for his appearance as the character Sabretooth in the blockbuster X-MEN and his supporting roles in SCORPION KING and TROY.

His other credits include such blockbuster feature films as DEVIL'S REJECTS, JOE DIRT and BLACK MASK II. He has also co-starred in the the epic 2005 mini-series HERCULES for HBO/Hallmark and the Creature Feature, HOW TO MAKE A MONSTER produced by Lou Arkoff and Stan Winston for Cinemax. He also appeared on such television shows as V.I.P., MONK, SON OF THE BEACH, PARTY OF FIVE, MY BOYS, GUNLESS, a western set in the Canadian west and most recently the thriller 247 FARENHEIT.

Producer Renae Geerlings comes to the Mane Entertainment team with a BA in Theatre and a twelve-year history producing Graphic Novels and comic books. Several of the published properties she worked on were developed or are still in development for film and television and video games such as WITCHBLADE, The DARKNESS, WANTED, MAGDALENA, and APHRODITE IX.

She also worked as Senior Editor for the award-winning Radical Publishing where she worked on projects with many big names in the film world including Sam Worthington, Patrick Tatopoulos, and Antoine Fuqua as well as the project that spawned the current film in production titled OBLIVION.

Anthony J. Rickert-Epstein - Director /Cinematographer/ Operator

Raised in Cincinnati, director and cinematographer A.J. RICKERT EPSTEIN and has been making films since he was 8 years old. Upon graduating from Miami University (OH) at the age of 20 with a degree in Mass Communications and Film Studies, A.J. had written, directed and completed his first feature film - *Fingerman: Dr. London and The Triangle Force*.

Ambitious and looking to hone his craft, A.J. sought out key opportunities to work along side talented directors and actors as a cinematographer and lensed the films *The Exodus of Charlie Wright*, starring Andy Garcia, Aidan Quinn, Mario Van Peebles, Danny Pino and Luke Goss, *We The Party*, directed by Mario Van Peebles and most recently *Dead Drop Sugarcane*.

As a director, A.J. has continued to be recognized by press and peers for his outstanding work. Most recently, his directing efforts for Jason Charles Miller's "Hey You" music video led to recognition by VH1 as one of "The Top 100 music videos of the 2000's".
